BeA Launches Corrugated Fastener Tool

The long magazine, which will accept staples in lengths 9mm, 12mm and 15mm, has a load capacity of 96 and features a single-handed catch for rapid and uncomplicated reloading. The angled front nose is suitable for 90° corner fixing.

The tool, which is weight balanced around the handle to reduce wrist strain, brings new meaning to the term user-friendly. The technologically advanced, lightweight tool has been designed and developed with operator comfort in mind to ensure excellent control and effortless operation. Anti-vibration protection to the handle means that the tool meets all the current requirements for vibration levels, whilst an exhaust silencer reduces noise output.
